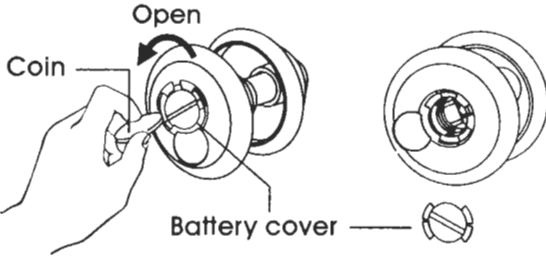

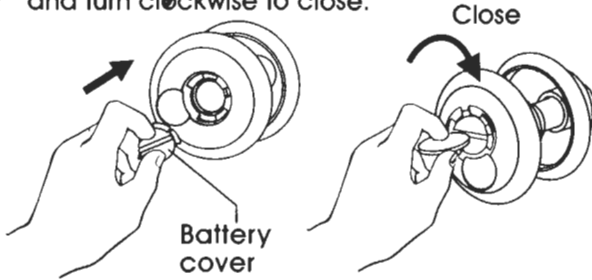
Battery Installation:

Not for children under 3 years

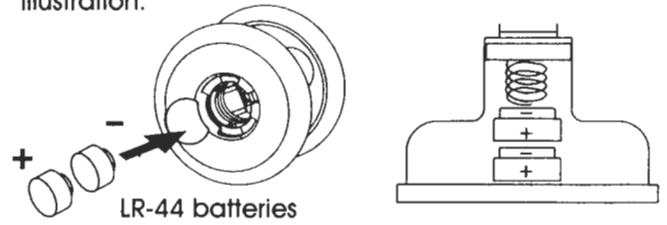
- 1 Using a small coin, turn the battery cover counter clockwise to open the battery case.



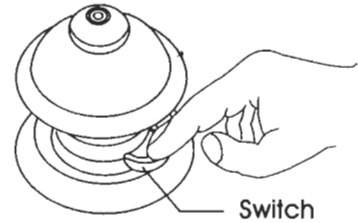
- 3 Place the battery cover back onto the base and turn clockwise to close.



- 2 Insert two LR-44 batteries (included in packaging) into the battery case. Make sure that the batteries are in the correct + and - polarity positions, as shown in the illustration.



- 4 You are now ready to switch the light on. Simply press down on the button located on the base, as shown in the illustration. To turn off, press the button again.

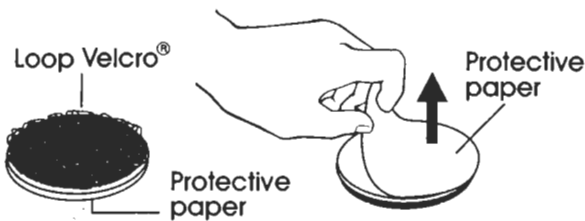


Battery Safety Information:

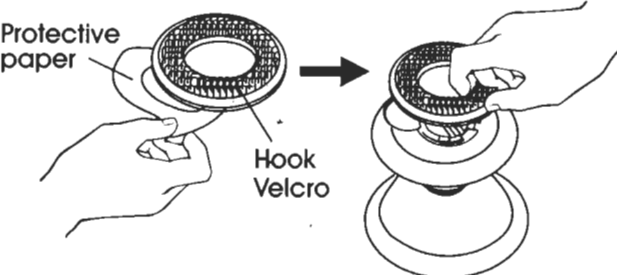
- Batteries are small objects. Battery installation and replacement should be handled only by adults.
- Batteries included in the packaging are non-rechargeable and should not be charged. Replacement batteries can be purchased at any store that carries similar/equivalent type batteries.
- Different types of batteries or new/used batteries should not be used in conjunction with one another.
- Only batteries of the same or equivalent type as those included in the packaging are to be used.
- Used batteries are to be removed from the toy and replaced with new batteries.
- Do not mix alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.

Velcro® Application For Ceiling Lamp:

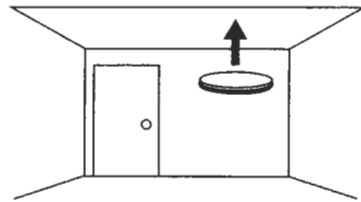
- 1 Tear off the protective paper from the loop Velcro®.



- 3 Tear off the protective paper from the hook Velcro. Place the adhesive side onto the base of the lamp, as shown in the illustration.



- 2 With the adhesive side facing up, place the loop Velcro® onto the ceiling of the room you have selected to place the ceiling lamp.



- 4 The hook Velcro® on the base of the ceiling lamp can now be adhered onto the loop Velcro® on the ceiling by simply placing the hook Velcro® onto the loop Velcro®. The additional Velcro® included in the packaging can be used to move the ceiling lamp to any other desired room.
